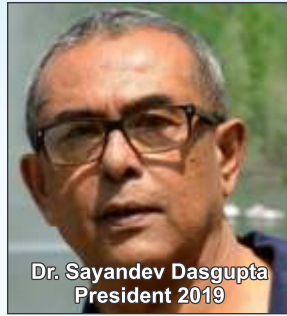

Exam Category

- ♦ Completed MS / DNB / MCh as of March 2019.
- ♦ Performed 25 laparoscopic procedures independently or jointly

- ♦ Attend endo-trainer and meet the professor sessions.

Written exam



There will be short essay or MCQ type questions for 100 marks. Candidates are required to obtain a minimum of 50 marks to pass. Answers should be brief and to the point.

Practical Exam. (in two parts)



1. The skill assessment on endo-trainer is based on performing simple to advanced exercises, approximately 10 minutes for each candidate. Maximum of 50 marks is allotted to endo-trainer assessment. Each candidate will be assessed by one examiner.
2. Interview / assessment for approximately 10 minutes for each candidate. The candidates are divided into batches and are interviewed by two or more faculty members of IAGES. Maximum of 50 marks

IAGES FELLOWSHIP COURSE

IAGES will conduct a 3 day fellowship course in Laparoscopy from 29, 30 & 31 March 2019 at SRMS-IMS, Bareilly. The course will be balanced mix of didactic lectures by eminent faculty with ample time for discussion, video presentations, open house sessions, symposia and direct informal interactions of groups with eminent faculty (meet the professor). Participants will get ample time on endo trainer under close guidance and supervision of faculty to improve their hand eye co-ordination by structured exercise.

On the third day, (i.e) 31 March 2019 a live operative workshop will be held at SRMS-IMS, Bareilly. Commonly practiced basic and advanced laparoscopic procedures will be shown by eminent faculty who are masters in their field with emphasis on the correct Techniques. The workshop shall be an open house interactive session with delegates as the central point. Lap appendix, Lap Chole TEP, TAPP and Lap fundoplication are few common procedures to be shown.

MEET THE PROFESSOR SESSION

It gives a good opportunity to young surgeons have interactive session which includes common basic and advanced procedures.

ENDOTRAINER SESSIONS

The endo trainer sessions are very important part of the fellowship course. The session will be for 90 minutes and will be supervised by a faculty member in batches of 6 to 8 candidates so that there can be a close interaction. During the session they will be trained on performance of specified tasks and specific exercises including endo knotting and suturing. On the last day the evaluation will be on the same exercises.
