
Hope the EC would come out with some positive inputs for the future growth of the association. Wishing to see you all soon.



The Minimal Access Surgical Clinics 2018 | GI Surgery

Process Driven Endo-Surgical Education - The Hour has Come!

Saturday, August 04, 2018 | Gurugram, NCR Institute of Minimal Access, Metabolic and Bariatric Surgery, Sir Ganga Ram Hospital, New Delhi



The GastroIntestinal System is a major surgical domaininMinimal Access Surgery. The volume and pace of scientific discovery in this arena often challenges established surgical dogma. This constant deluge of information can have an unsettling effect on the surgeon. Professional safety in such an environment is best preserved by the critique of the clinic where fundamentals are reiterated, and so-called progress is soundly questioned. The 'Minimal Access Surgical Clinics' was designed around this academic rigour. The agenda for the clinic was sourcedand short-listed from a national survey of practicing surgeons. Leading national and international faculty were then invited to address the clinical contentions that seize current surgical practice.

The first edition, the 'Minimal Access Surgical Clinics 2018 | GI Surgery'was conducted on August 04, 2018 at the Olympus Centre of Excellence, Gurugram, NCR. The 'Clinic' was organised by the Institute of Minimal Access, Metabolic and Bariatric Surgery, Sir Ganga Ram Hospital, New Delhi under the aegis of the Indian Association of Gastrointestinal Endo Surgeons (IAGES) and the Delhi State Chapter of Association of Surgeons of India. It was also supported by the academic initiative of the nascent Association of Board Certified Minimal Access Surgeons (ABMAS).

This cognitive fiesta at the happening locale of Gurugram was designed as aneducation-intense, high faculty-delegateratio event to create best impact. The high-value nature of the clinic resulted in registrations exceeding twice the planned limit. Full faculty attendance, a jam-packed hall, cutting edge presentations and a sharp-routine heightened the academic excitement. A radical initiative of the clinic has been the launch of a comprehensive repository of minimal access GI surgical Clinical Practice Guidelines (CPG) from national and international societies, which can be found on the CPG pagewww.masc.net.in/cpg/. CPGs currently have huge professional, legal and regulatory implications and it is our ardent belief that greater awareness of these will drive safe and successful clinical care and research in India. 


