

The new procedure of Spyglass for removal of difficult stones from biliary tree was also demonstrated.

"Lapguru" took the initiative of web telecasting Live the programme on its portals.

Dr. Subhash Khanna, President elect IAGES and also the Organising Chairman while addressing the delegates made a special mention of the efforts of Prof. B. Report of the Second Fellowship in **Advanced Laparoscopic Abdominal** Wall Hernia Surgery

The 2nd FALS HERNIA course was held at Sri Ramachandra University, Chennai under the aegis of Indian Association of Gastrointestinal Endo Surgeons. For the first time in FALS Course International Live Operative Workshop was transmitted from Spain, Europe and International Panel Discussion was organised with five universities across the United States of America.

The fellowship program was held under the Patronage of Shri V R Venkataachalam, Chancellor, Sri Ramachandra University. Prof K Balaji Singh was the Organising Chairman, Dr M Kanagavel was the Organising Secretary, Dr Naveen Alexander was the Joint Secretary and Dr Rajiv Raj was the Treasurer. Dr H P Garg, the Chief Convenor of the FALS Board, guided us through all the aspects of planning, academics and execution of this advanced course. The President Dr A Zameer Pasha, Immediate Past President Dr Ramesh Agarwalla, Secretary Dr Sayandevdas Gupta and Treasurer Dr Ramen Goel, All the office bearers, VP South zone and EC members helped us to conduct a flawless program.

Our Sincere thanks to Prof B Krishna Rau Sir, Dr Pradeep Chowbey Sir and Dr Ajay Kriplani Sir for helping us to fine tune the program.

More than 104 candidates participated in this International event. A total of 64 candidates participated in the fellowship. More than 40 non-fellowship candidates took part in the deliberations. About 32 faculty of National Repute and 7 International faculty had scientific contributions on diverse advanced topics on various aspects of Abdominal Wall Hernia.

The program was planned to have groin hernia topics on day 1, abdominal wall hernia on day2 and live workshop on day 3. There was live workshop from Spain on Groin hernia on day 1 and Lumbar Hernia on day 2.

Invoking the blessings of divinity, the course started with a brief introduction by Dr HP Garg. Dr Sayandevdas Gupta outlined the course plan and the academic planning for the event. The following expert faculty shared their valuable experience on various topics. 

Over 150 surgeons from India and abroad gathered together for the IAGES Fellowship in Advanced Laparoscopic Colo Rectal Surgery (FALS-CRS) 2017 organised by the Institute of Minimal Access, Metabolic and Bariatric Surgery (iMAS), Sir Ganga Ram Hospital, New Delhi this October 13-15, 2017 under the aegis of the Indian Association of Gastrointestinal Endo Surgeons (IAGES). Starting each day sharply at 8AM, Fellows, Delegates and Faculty interacted intensively over the fundamentals and intricate details of minimal access colo rectal surgery. The mandate set by the FALS-CRS 2017 Team under its Organising Chairman, Dr. Parveen Bhatia and Organising Secretary Dr. Suviraj John was to provide the latest academic training possible to the course fellows and delegates along with warm hosting by Organising Co-Chairman Dr. Sudhir Kalhan, Organising Co-Secretaries Dr. Mukund Khetan and Dr. Vivek Bindal. The course had the full support of the IAGES office in Dr. Zameer Pasha, President IAGES, Dr. Sayandev Dasgupta, Secretary IAGES, Dr. HP Garg, FALS Convenor and IAGES Zonal Executives. It was inaugurated by one of India's eminent physician's, Prof. PS Gupta, senior physician at Sir Ganga Ram Hospital. Faculty were leading Indian and international colo rectal surgeons with large pioneering expertise in laparoscopic, robotic and trans-anal colo rectal surgery.
