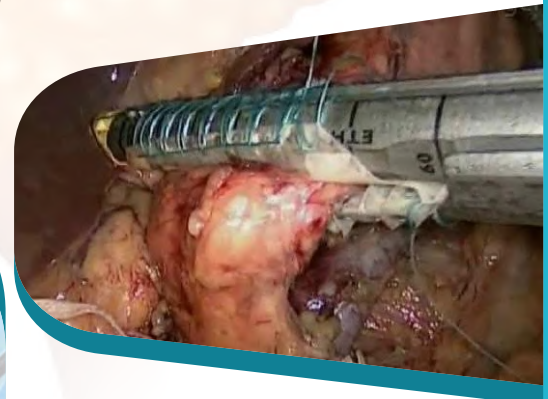

Eligibility Criteria for Fellowship (FALS - HPB)

A) Examination Category:

- ❖ Minimum of 5 years experience in Laparoscopic surgery after postgraduation including experience in Laparoscopic HPB/ Spleen surgery
- ❖ Should have performed a minimum of 15 Laparoscopic HPB/ Spleen procedures independently or under supervision.
- ❖ Should attend Fellowship course on all 3 days.
- ❖ Have to appear for written examination and interview.
- ❖ Submission of log book of Laparoscopic HPB cases, certified by HOD or self, if working in own set up, at the time of attendance of course.
- ❖ Submission of a CD (at the time of interview) with a recording of two Laparoscopic HPB surgical procedures is desirable, but not mandatory

B) Non Examination Category:

- ❖ Minimum 10 years after post-graduation with experience in Laparoscopic HPB and Spleen surgeries.
- ❖ Should have performed at least 50 laparoscopic HPB and Spleen surgeries independently.
- ❖ Should attend Fellowship course on all 3 days and appear for Interview (Candidates in this category are exempted from Written examination).
- ❖ Submission of log book of Laparoscopic HPB cases, certified by HOD or self, if working in own set up, at the time of attendance of course.
- ❖ Submission of a CD (at the time of interview) with a recording of two Laparoscopic HPB surgical procedures is desirable, but not mandatory
- ❖ If the above criteria are not fulfilled, he or she will be shifted to the examination category

Award of Fellowship (FALS-HPB)

Successful candidates will be awarded the Fellowship in Laparoscopic Hepato-pancreato-biliary Surgery (FALS-HPB) at the convocation ceremony which will be held during the annual conference of IAGES in February 2023 at Coimbatore. Registration at the Annual Conference is Mandatory.
