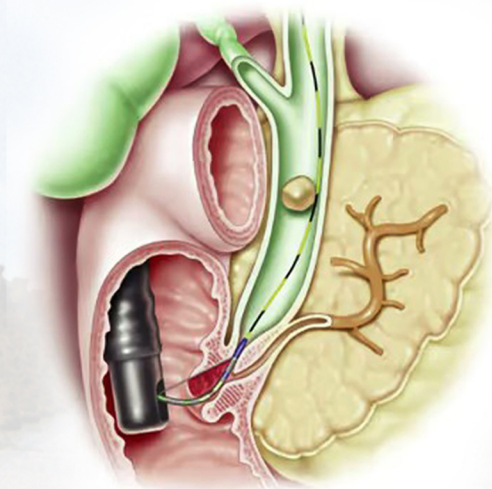

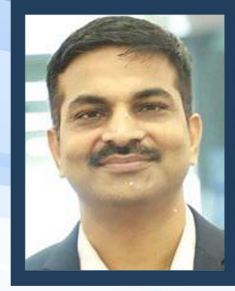

ABOUT FAGIE AND ITS IMPORTANCE

Indian Association of Gastrointestinal Endo surgeons is a growing and vibrant organization with about 9000 members. It is an internationally renowned academic body with the vision of promoting and spreading the art and science of minimal access surgery throughout India and abroad. Friendship, Fellowship and knowledge sharing are the key strengths of IAGES.

Structured endoscopic training is the need of the hour for all surgeons. While our surgical fraternity is witnessing revolution in the field of laparoscopic surgery, it is true that at present only few surgeons are competent in doing endoscopic therapeutic procedures. Endoscopic skills are more than necessary in the era of laparoscopy. Endoscopy laparoscopy interface is very essential for all of us in the coming years. Hence IAGES has constituted Endoscopy board to frame and conduct flexible endoscopy training courses and to confer fellowship certification on successful assessment of eligible surgeons.

Further to the successful EFIAGES (Basic flexible endoscopy fellowship course) since 2016, IAGES has started advanced therapeutic endoscopy and colonoscopy course (FAGIE) for all IAGES members since 2018. Flexible endoscopy platform is increasingly used by surgeons for various surgical treatment nowadays. Hence IAGES has now come out with FAGIE course in 4 different subspecialties in the line of FALS course (Fellowship in Advanced Laparoscopic Surgery) which have been conducted in 7 different subspecialties.

We propose to have followed 4 different FAGIE courses, each with clear learning objectives from surgeon's perspective to help them to acquire the knowledge and skills needed to perform various surgical interventions in the flexible endoscopy platform.

- **FAGIE- EUS:** Advanced endoscopy Fellowship course for surgeons:
 - ✦ Diagnostic and basic therapeutic EUS applications
- **FAGIE-ERCP :** Advanced endoscopy Fellowship course for Surgeons
 - ✦ ERCP and Spyglass with biliary and pancreatic interventions
- **FAGIE-Colonoscopy :** Advanced endoscopy fellowship course for surgeons
 - ✦ Diagnostic and therapeutic colonoscopy
- **FAGIE- Therapeutic UGIE:** Advanced endoscopy fellowship course for surgeons
 - ✦ Upper GI therapeutic interventions

GUIDELINES FOR FAGIE-ERCP

Indian Association of Gastrointestinal Endo surgeons is a growing and vFAGIE Eligibility Criteria

- Must be a member of IAGES. Those who are not members may now apply for membership to apply for FAGIE courses. Please go to IAGES website for more details. (www.iages.in)
- Ideally one should have successfully completed EFIAGES fellowship course and present the logbook with adequate diagnostic and therapeutic endoscopic experience. Only on exceptional circumstances, members would be allowed to take FAGIE directly after considering their extensive endoscopic and teaching experience.
- Applicants should furnish the consolidated sheet of endoscopy experience from their own logbook with total number of diagnostic and therapeutic GI endoscopic procedures in the following format while submitting their application for the FAGIE course namely
 - ✦ Diagnostic upper GI endoscopy done
 - ✦ Therapeutic endoscopy
 - FB removal
 - Banding/Sclerotherapy
 - Dilatation
 - Others
 - ✦ Diagnostic colonoscopy
 - ✦ Therapeutic colonoscopy
 - Hot biopsy/Polypectomy
 - ✦ ERCP
 - ✦ EUS
 - ✦ Any other procedures like ESD/EMR/POEM

Highlights of the Course

- 3 days of well supervised Hands on advanced endoscopic course in the chosen speciality in high volume clinical setting
- Live case demonstration, simulator training and lecture modules by panel of experts
- 5 online lecture and recorded live cases in the chosen subspeciality from centres of excellence each for 1 hour
- Online discussion platform for clarification of any doubts in the syllabus
- Part I and Part 2 assessment

Part 1

- MCQ and Viva and Practical during 3-day onsite course

Part 2

- Submission of logbook with required number of cases prescribed for each FAGIE subspecialty (assisted and done under supervision)
- Part 2 MCQ on Day 1 of Annual conference

Fellowship certification will be given during convocation on the final day of annual congress



FAGIE ERCP ASSESSMENT

Examination Category:

Part 1 Assessment

- MCQ on Day 2 for 50 questions / 50 marks
- Viva for 10 minutes (20 marks)
- Practical assessment in Virtual simulator/animal model (20 marks)
- Log book (10 marks)

Part 2 Assessment

- MCQ on Day 1 of annual conference for 100 questions/ 100 marks
- Log book submission with prescribed number of ERCP procedures done or assisted

All FAGIE candidates should take up the examination. Only on satisfactory completion of both parts of assessment he/she would be eligible for 'FAGIE'-ERCP'

Certified members would receive the fellowship certificate during the convocation at the subsequent IAGES annual conference

Non Examination Category:

- Suitable for those candidates working as faculty in teaching institution and all surgeons with more than 10-year experience in doing endoscopy and ERCP
- Already IAGES member or should be eligible to become IAGES members
- Apply with an additional letter to the convener of the course clearly stating the number of endoscopy and colonoscopy done in the last 10 years and also mention regarding extent of ERCP experience till date.
- Would be eligible to receive the FAGIE ERCP fellowship on satisfactory completion of the course and the informal interview. Decision of Endoscopy board is final.

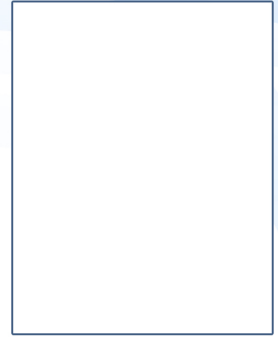
