FIAGES – FELLOWSHIP OF INDIAN ASSOCIATION OF GASTROINTESTINAL ENDO SURGEONS

IAGES - BASIC FELLOWSHIP COURSE (FIAGES)

The IAGES will conduct a FIAGES course at Jupiter Hospital from the 26th July 2024 to 28th July 2024. This course will focus on all the basics of laparoscopy. The course will be a balanced mix of didactic lectures by eminent faculty with ample time for discussions, video presentations, open house session, symposium, panel discussion and direct informal interactions of groups with eminent faculty. There will be many unique features in the course to make it more useful, convenient and memorable for you.

LIVE WORKSHOP AND LAPAROSCOPIC SURGERY:

A live operating workshop will be held on Jupiter Hospital Thane. Commonly practiced basic and advanced laparoscopic procedures will be demonstrated by eminent faculties who have mastered in their fields with emphasis on the current guidelines. The workshop shall be an open house interactive session with the delegates and fellows as the centre point.

ASSESSMENT FOR CERTIFICATION:

All the candidates will be assessed for the certification after attending all the sessions. The method of assessment will depend on whether the candidates are in the “examination category” or “non examination category”

ELIGIBILITY FOR FIAGES COURSE:

IAGES membership is mandatory. (If you are not an IAGES Member, you may apply for the same at www.iages.in and give the required details to pay online for IAGES registration. Please pay 8260 (Registration Fees ₹7000 + 18% GST) as membership fees. After submitting the form, you will be directed with Payment gateway and on successful completion, your registration will be automatically accepted. Membership numbers will be given to members after successful completion of payment and it will be given in 2 weeks from the Honorary Secretary's office.

NON EXAMINATION CATEGORY:

Surgeons who have been doing basic laparoscopic surgery for 10 or more years are eligible for the non-examination category. Candidates should have performed more than 100 basic laparoscopic surgeries and need to submit a logbook to substantiate the claim. Attendance is mandatory. For all the candidate fellows should have an experience certificate from the head of the department (HOD), employer or self (If owning a hospital). All the candidates will have a viva assessment by the ESboard of examiners on July 28th at Jupiter Hospital, Thane before awarding fellowship.

FIAGES – FELLOWSHIP OF INDIAN ASSOCIATION OF GASTROINTESTINAL ENDO SURGEONS

EXAMINATION CATEGORY

All surgeons with a post graduate degree in surgery is mandatory with a minimum of two years' experience in laparoscopic surgery (includes experience in laparoscopy as a resident) can apply in this category. The applicant should have performed over 25 laparoscopic procedures either jointly or independently. Full attendance is mandatory on all three days of the course for all the candidates. Fellow should have an experience certificate from the head of the department (HOD), employee or self (if owning a hospital) as supportive documents. Written examination and viva assessment will be conducted on July 28th at Jupiter Hospital, Thane. The written examination will comprise of 100 MCQS with a total mark of 100 and passing marks will be 50 marks. Viva will be 100 Marks and passing marks will be 50 marks.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR COURSE PARTICIPANTS:

Attendance is compulsory on all three days

The grand convocation will take place on later date and venue where all the fellows will be facilitated with a degree

Participants are requested to reach the venue in Jupiter Hospital, Thane on or before 08:00 hrs on 26th July

Registrations will be open on 26th July 2024 from 07:00 hrs at Jupiter Hospital, Thane.

All candidates are requested to bring a copy of their MBBS certificate, MS/DNB Degree Certificate and MCI registration at the time of registration.

All candidates must bring a copy of their log books attested by their HOD or an experience certificate from the head of the department (HOD), employee or self (if owning a hospital) as supportive documents.

Participants in the non-examination category will appear for a viva assessment on 28th July 2024 at Jupiter Hospital, Thane.

All exam category participants are requested to be present for MCQ's and viva assessment at the announced time on July 28th 2024 at Jupiter Hospital, Thane.

The last sign out is on Sunday 28th July 2024 after 16:00 hrs.

AWARD OF FELLOWSHIP CERTIFICATE:

Fellowship certificate will be given only in person with successful completion in both the categories at a Grand Convocation ceremony at IAGES

Delegates registering for the conference are requested to participate in the convocation.
